Still confusion about the role of the YS meetings, but not the battle we thought it would be. AM has not heard anything back since she questioned the minutes of the meeting on 27/11/08. Positive meeting. Met lots of people from different schools of yoga. Made it clear that Yoga Scotland is not the governing body for all yoga types. There was no progress however on the IYA[UK] proposal which was to jointly develop a national yoga qualification with Yoga Scotland. YS saw a national qualification as something they wanted to pursue on their own with the Scottish Qualification Authority [SQA]. Overall the outcome of the meeting was a positive one in that ESIYI were seen as positive and keen to work together to improve yoga standards in Scotland, while at the same time firm on the issue of governance. Linda will keep us in touch with developments on the issue of yoga regulation and national yoga qualifications, which is being explored on our behalf by IYA [UK].</p>	Linda
